Self-Assessment/Attestation: IMPORTANT: Thank-you for completing these important steps as we continue to follow the direction of Public Health and the Ministry of Health. **SOME STUDENTS WHO PRESENT WITH SYMPTOMS SAY THAT THEY DO NOT COMPLETE THE SELF-ASSESSMENT BEFORE COMING TO SCHOOL. Reminder: Only sign the Attestation Calendar if your child has completed and passed the self-assessment. If your child fails the self-assessment (has any of the symptoms), then he/she cannot come to school. If they present with symptoms at school, they will need to go home along with siblings.
